## Expectations for use of the site

Sydney ConFesters is committed to keeping our site user friendly and leaving it as good, if not better, as when we arrived.

### Arrival and departure

- Arrive at the start dates & times as stated in invite, don't arrive early or leave late
- Stay within the bounds of the site that we are hiring.

### Cars

- No cars to move across site after dark
- Restrict car movement on site. Drive slowly and carefully in spaces where people are camping.

### Fires

- Use fire pit only, no individual camp fires

### Rubbish

- Sydney ConFesters values recycling and cleanliness
- Take your personal rubbish home with you
- Take some kitchen surplus rubbish home as well
- Recycle as much rubbish as possible
- Sort kitchen rubbish into the correct bins

### Noise

- Sydney ConFesters values the sounds of nature.
- Consider your fellow neighbours and restrict noise (including talking and laughing) in tent areas after 10pm.
- Go to designated communal areas (eg Fire pit and communal spaces) if you want to chat or make music at night.
- Consider the use of the space at that time – are people in a quiet zone or a discussion zone or a playful zone?
- Amplified music is only allowed in designated spaces and at designated times.
- Acoustic music is welcome in all communal spaces.

Our agreement with TOAC includes but not limited to the following;

- No nuts or glass onsite
- Stay within our site boundaries, do not access site's buildings or Outdoor Adventure activity equipment
- Put organic waste, except tea bags, in bin provided. This waste is fed to the cows.

## Our agreement with 40 Acres

40 Acres welcome any event that is respectful to the pristine environment that we are lucky to be immersed in.

There are 4 agreements

- No chemicals whatsoever in the creek (no shampoo, soap, detergent, sunscreen, insect repellent etc)
- Leave no trace - all rubbish to be taken away with you (and not placed in any bins along Ourimbah Creek Rd)
- All attendees asked to drive slowly down the gravel road coming in and out of the property - there are many walkers, cyclists, horse riders, kids and wildlife on the road
- Quiet time at night (for both neighbours and native wildlife) so no loud amplified music or drums past 10.30pm.

Water

- BYO drinking water
- All water on the property is unfiltered rainwater and/or creek water. Please be mindful and keep showers short so as to have enough for everyone.
